Specialty Contracting Revenues Include:

- Prime and specialty contracts awarded to your firm by the owner.
- Subcontracts received from other contractors.
- The value of materials and fabrication but only if the procurement, fabrication and installation is included in the scope of the self- performed portion of your construction contract. Thus, do not include revenue from fabrication or supply contracts that will be erected or installed by your subcontractors, even if you hold the primary subcontracts for their erection or installation.
- Operations and maintenance contracts that include construction activities.

Exclude the following Revenues:

- Revenue from subsidiaries or internal corporate groups, divisions, business units or departments engaged exclusively in non- construction activities.
- Revenue from general contracting.
- Revenue from non-contracting or third-party manufacturing, fabrication and sales, leases or rental of products, materials or equipment.
